

# Super Bowl Squares/Football Pool Instructions

Start with an empty 10 by 10 grid. This will give you 100 Squares that you can let your Users select. People can sign their initials in the box they choose. All squares must be purchased.

Once all the squares have been filled, it is time to assign the numbers. Randomly assign numbers 0 through 9 to each column, followed by doing the same for each row. Now each square represents a specific score in the game based on the column and row numbers.

Your Football Squares grid is now complete, and you just need to wait until the game is played to determine who will be your winners. A winner is usually determined at the end of the 1st Half, and Final Game score. The winner is determined by looking at the last number in each of the teams' score, and then matching those numbers on the grid and seeing which square intersects those two numbers. An example would be if the Miami Dolphins were playing the New York Giants in the Super Bowl, and the score at halftime was Miami Dolphins 33, and NY Giants 24. The last number for the Dolphins is 3, and the last number for the Giants is 4. The square on the grid that has the Dolphins with a number of 3, and Giants score of 4, would be the winner.
